Exhibition Brief:

Mapping Harbord Village: Stories of a Neighbourhood is an exhibition that showcases the urban life of Harbord Village inspired by the memories of its residents. Their photographs and oral histories evoke the neighborhood through the use of three common themes: foodscapes, laneways, and porches - which provide a glimpse into the daily life of Harbord Village.

Who We Are:

This exhibition was developed in partnership with the Harbord Village Residents' Association (HVRA) and the Master of Museum Studies in the Faculty of Information at the University of Toronto.

The HVRA won a Trillium Foundation grant to launch the first phase of its Harbord Village History Programme: an oral history project based upon interviews with longtime neighbourhood residents. The project includes a website and a series of StoryPosts - plaques mounted throughout the neighbourhood containing links to sound clips that bring neighbourhood memories to life.
